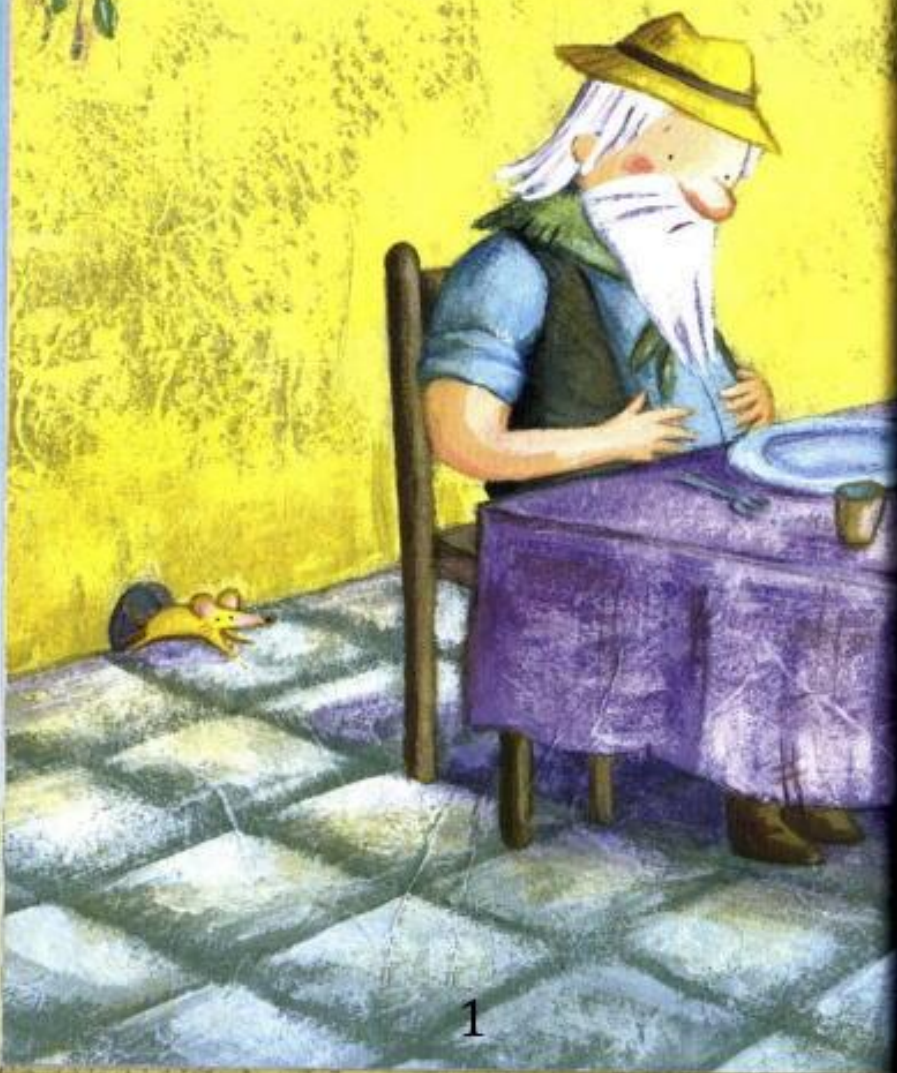

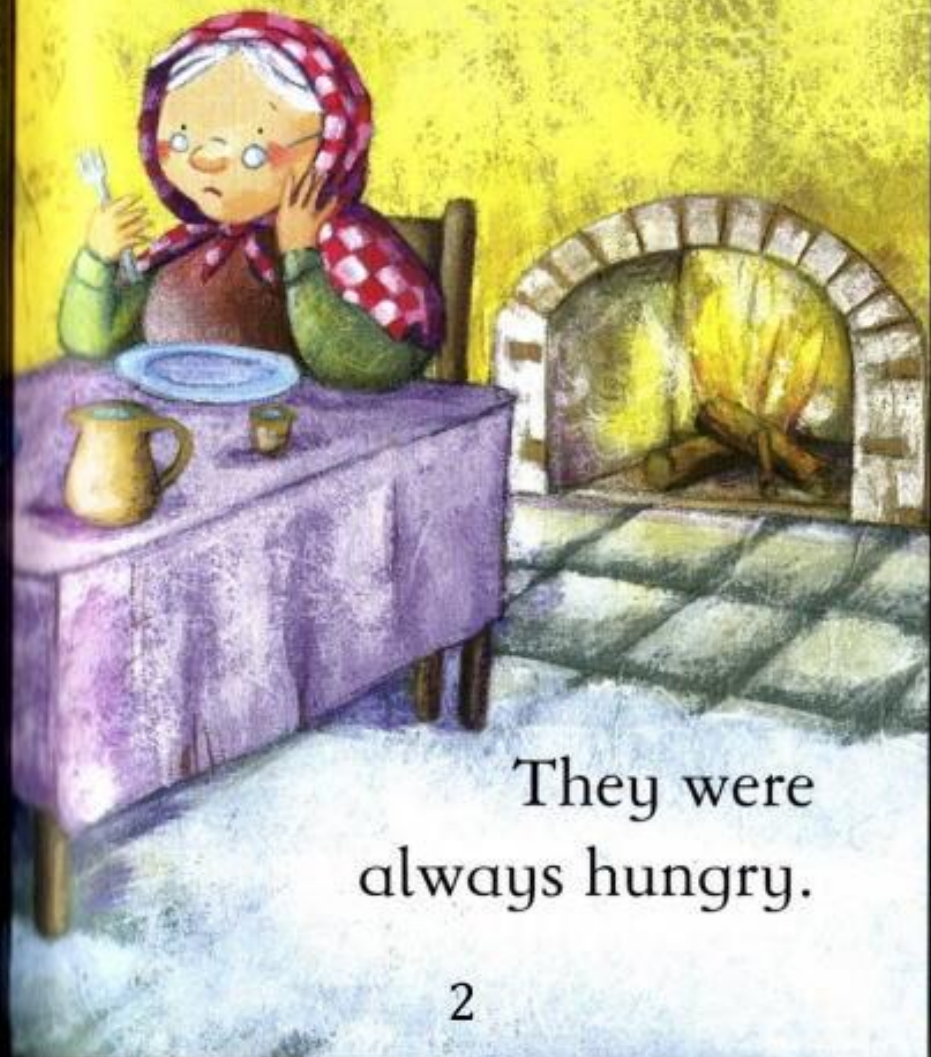


Yosaku and Mugi were
hungry.



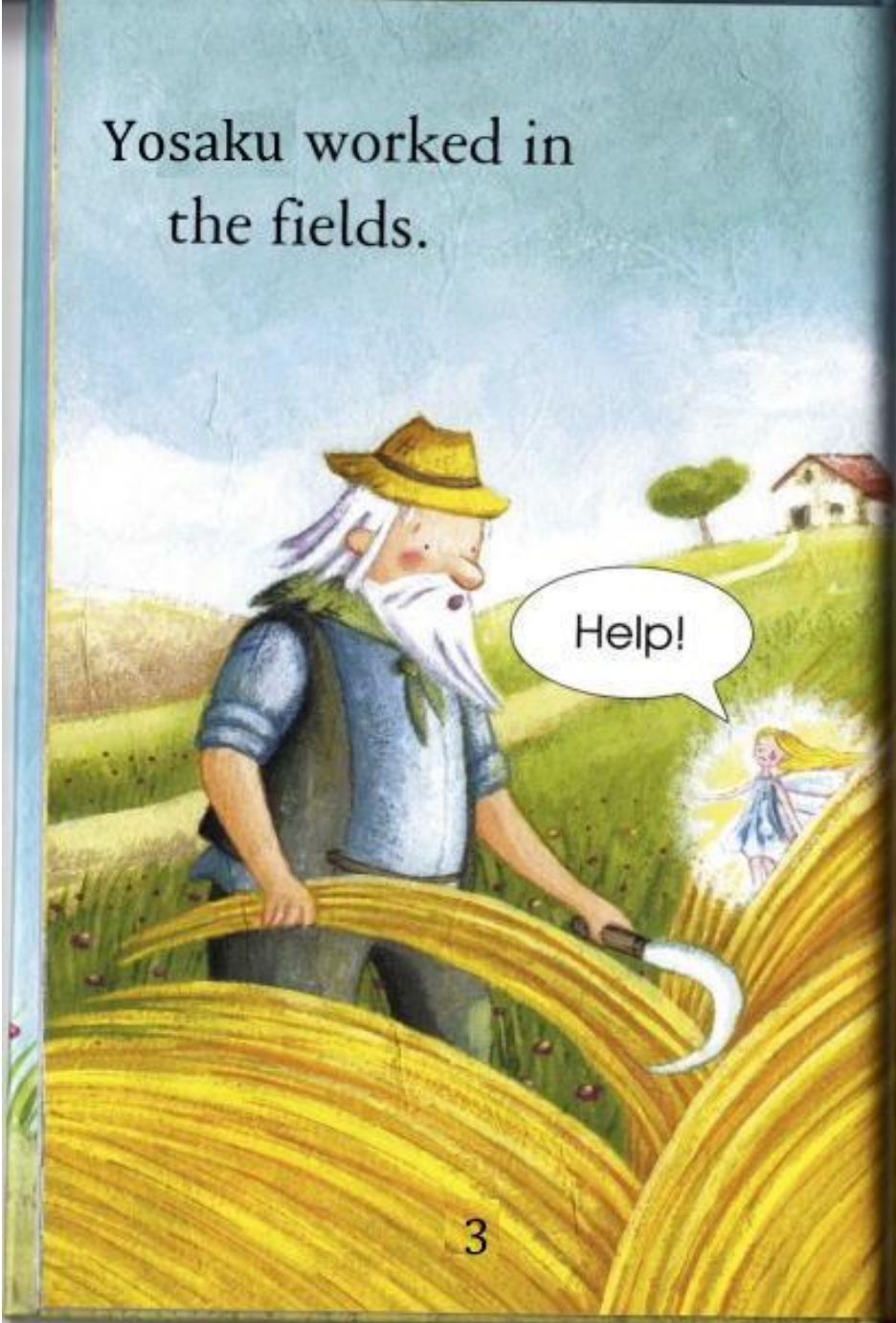

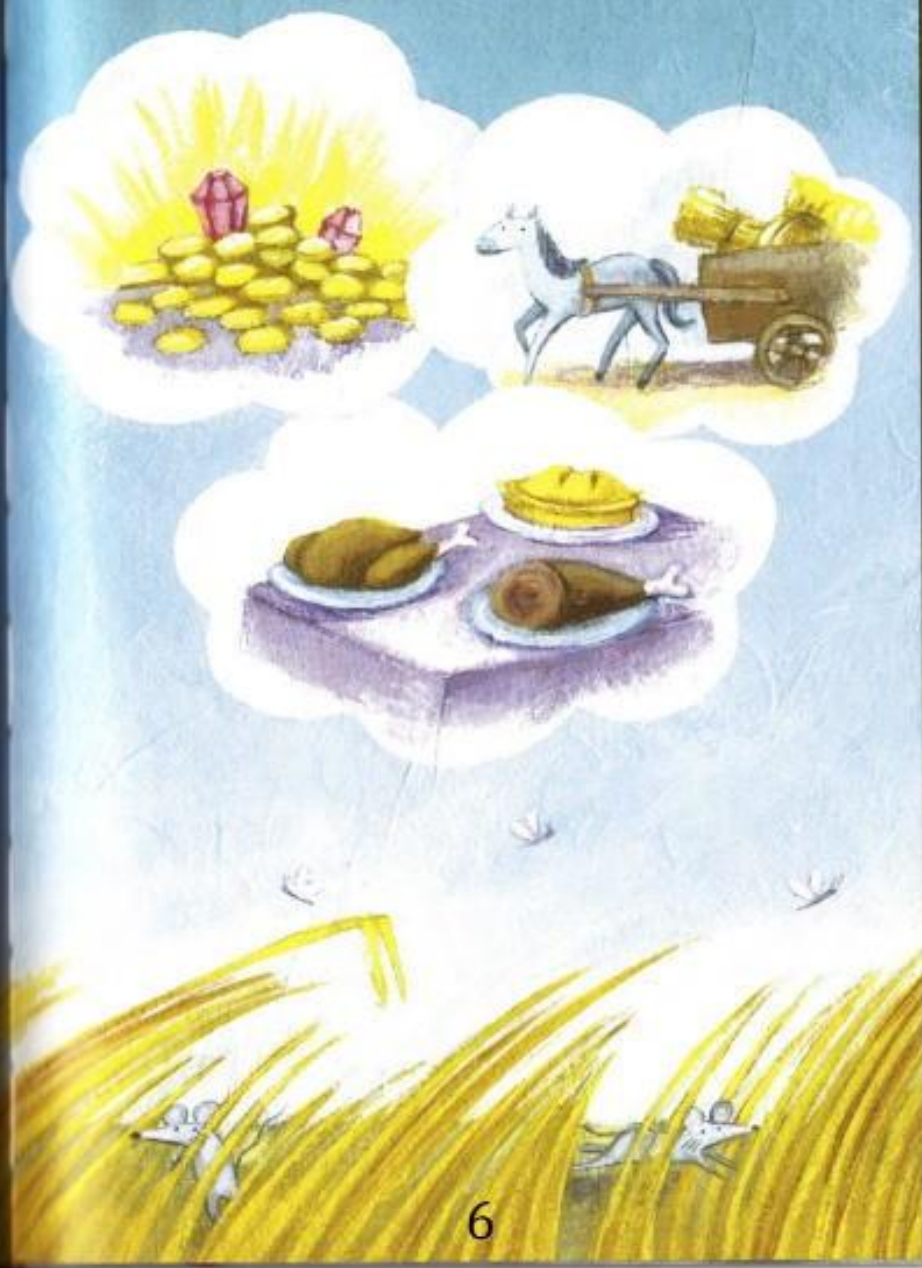

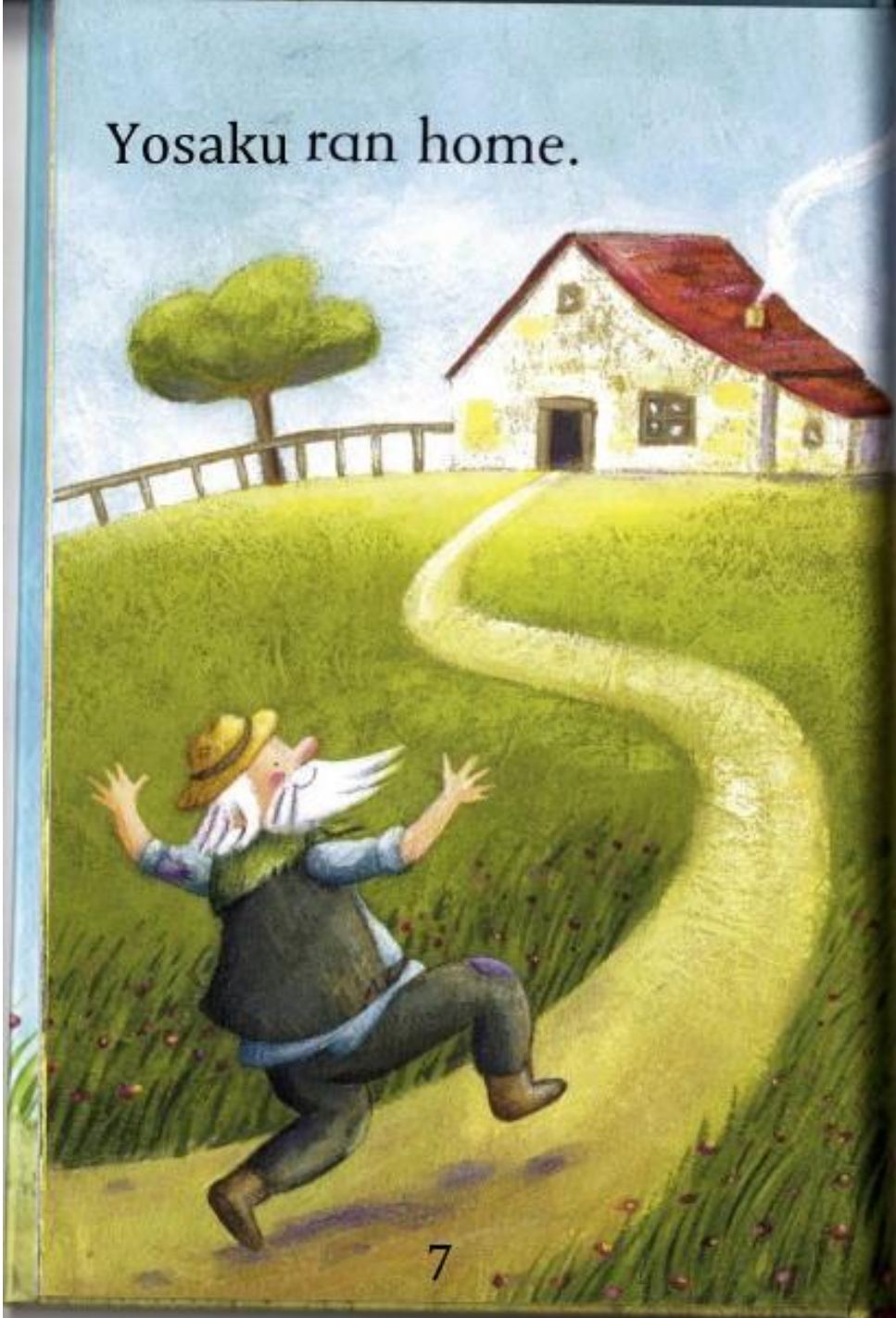

"Mugi! We have three wishes!" he shouted.

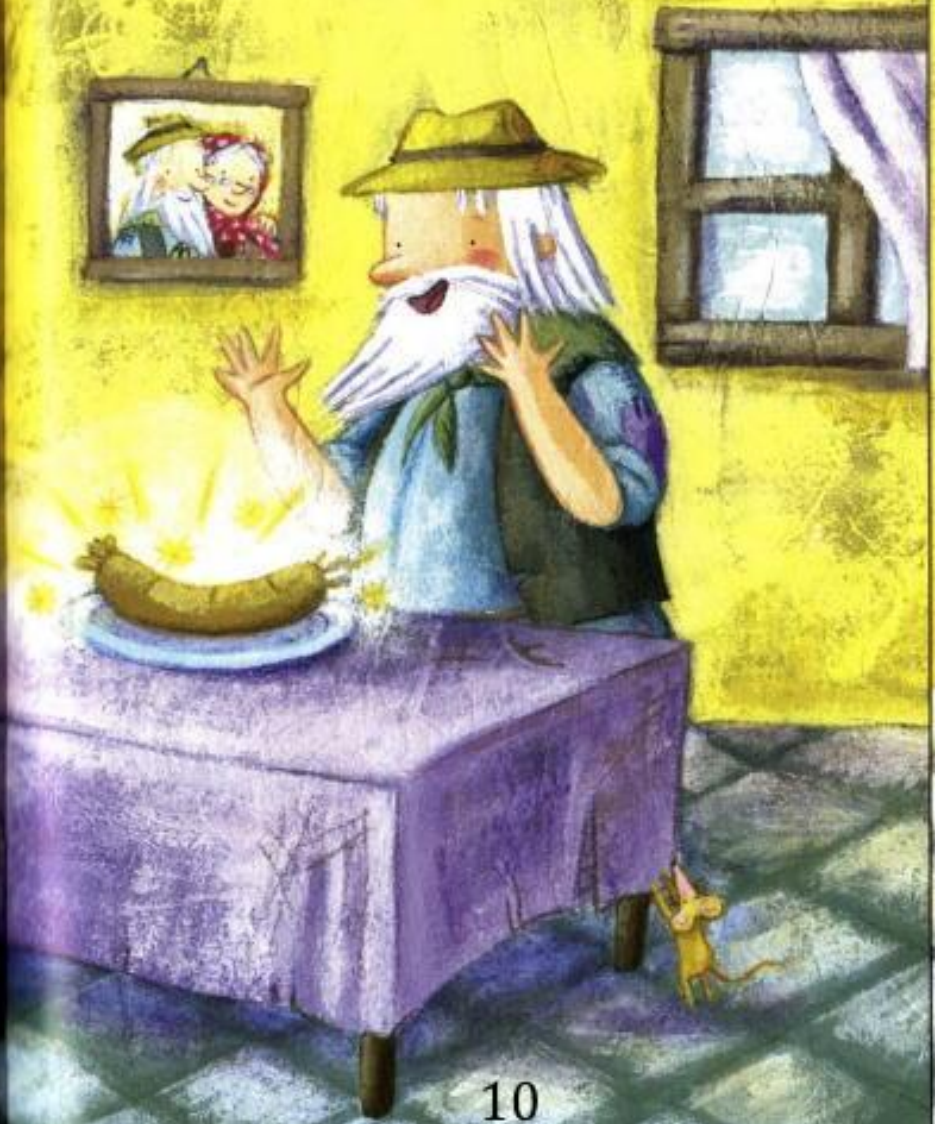
